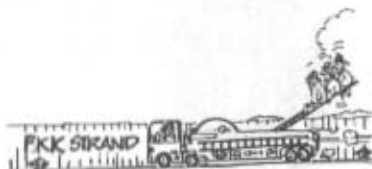

INTERVIEW WITH FRANKIE OF ALPHA FLIGHT

- PIRATES: What's your name and your group you belong to?
FRANKIE: I called myself Frankie and I belong to the group ALPHA FLIGHT since 1984.
- PIRATES: How old are you?
FRANKIE: I'm in the golden age of 18.
- PIRATES: Please tell how your very beginning was and on which machine you started.
FRANKIE: In 1984 I got a C-64 and since the beginning of 87` I own an Amiga.
- PIRATES: And what is your function now in ALPHA FLIGHT?
FRANKIE: I am one of two who called themselves chief-editors and our business is to put out the wellknown CRACKER JOURNAL every month(?).
- PIRATES: Do you remember the first game that was cracked by AFL?
FRANKIE: Yes it was the game WERNER which I bought by Data Becker on Christmas eve 85`.
- PIRATES: Do you have a girl-friend?
FRANKIE: Of course!
- PIRATES: And which kind of music do you prefer?
FRANKIE: All kinds except Acid-shit.
- PIRATES: What's your political position?
FRANKIE: Everybody thinks what he thinks.
- PIRATES: What are your best friends in the rough scene?
FRANKIE: Mostly all ALPHA FLIGHT members.
- PIRATES: What's your opinion about copy-parties? Why you go to a copy-party, cause of new stuff or what?
FRANKIE: Copy-parties are quiet nice things. But I only visit them in order to meet some friends and have little conversations with them.
- PIRATES: What do you think about ALPHA FLIGHT as their position in the scene? I heard that many guys said that ALPHA FLIGHT only survived cause of their CRACKER JOURNAL, do you think even so?
FRANKIE: Yes, it is right that the CRACKER JOURNAL is our sign, but we do also some other things like our Compacted-Disks and the AFL-Trainers. It is right that we don't crack so much like Quartex, Vision Factory or Parancima but we are still one of the better ones.
- PIRATES: As you said "We are still one of the better ones", what do you think bout the "Nr.1-Virus" which goes around(Quartex or on the 64 Elite, Ikari, Nato...)?
FRANKIE: Who claim the privilege to be Nr.1 is a big swaggerer! Personally I don't know anyone who has the right to pretend himself as the real Nr.1.
- PIRATES: What's your opinion about the software companies?
FRANKIE: You know it all, great name shit game! I think that most of the companies, not all, only have a look on the money. They don't care about the quality they only see the money. And this is what gonna makes me angry, you buy a game for a horrible high price and for this you get an average game-play with average graphics and sampled sounds. That's not the right way!

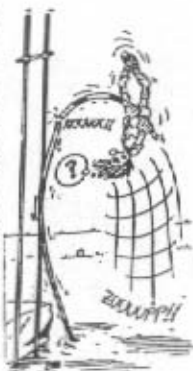
ALPHA FLIGHT PARTY REPORT

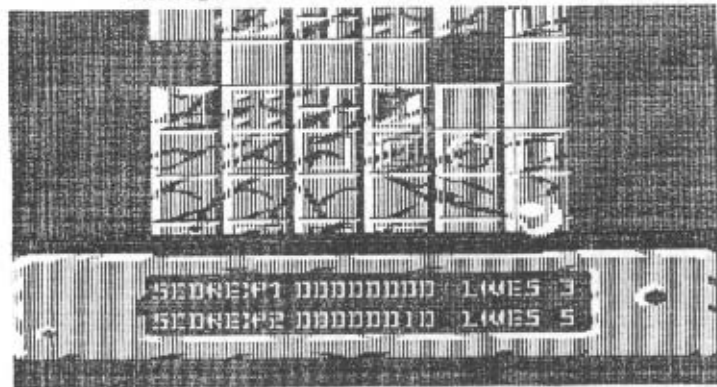

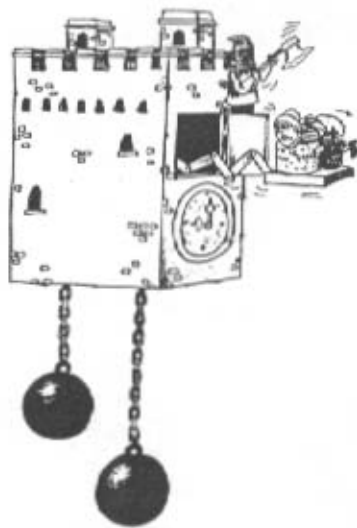
