

## Project 1 — Photo Cube Dots

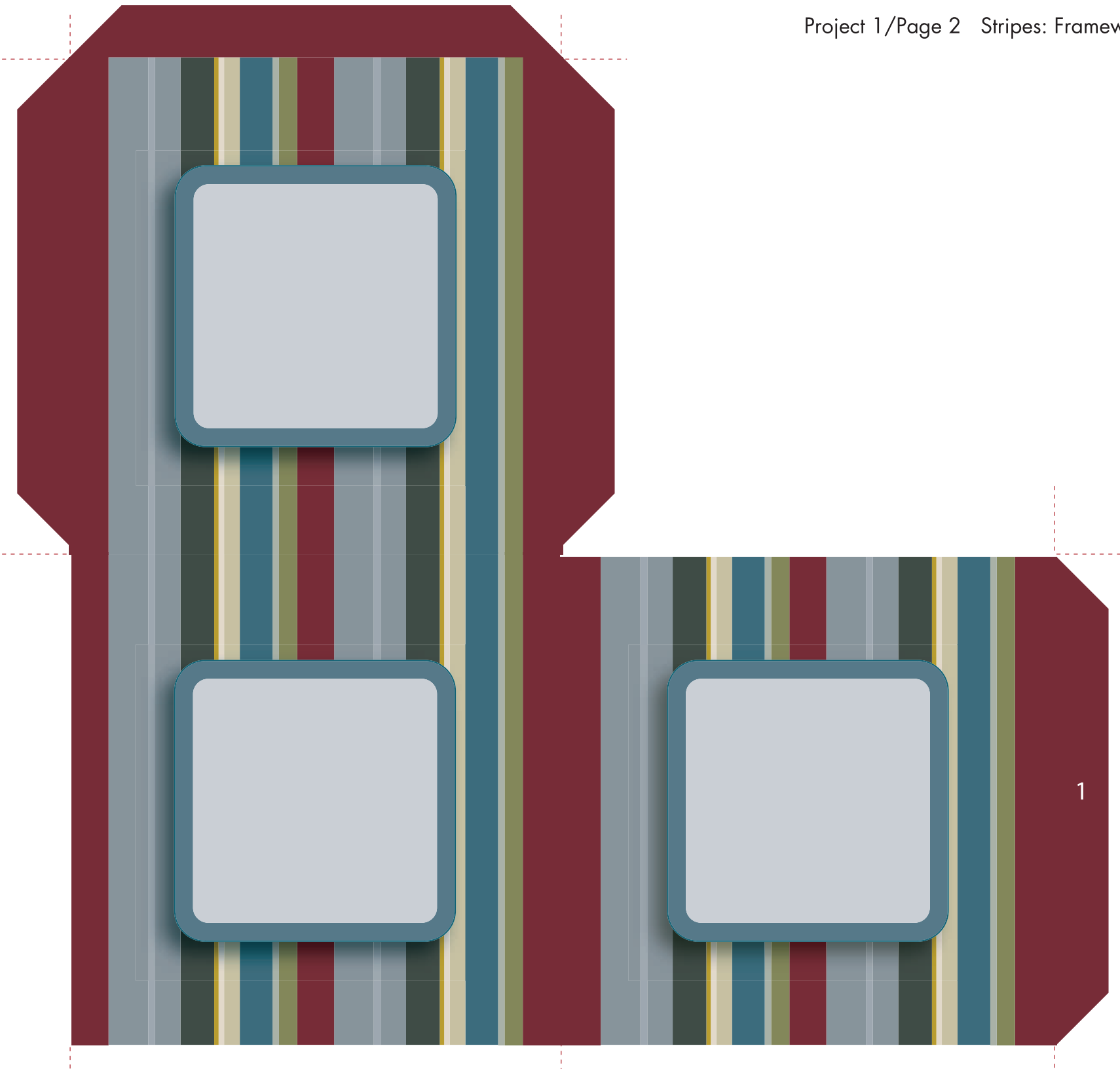
### Materials

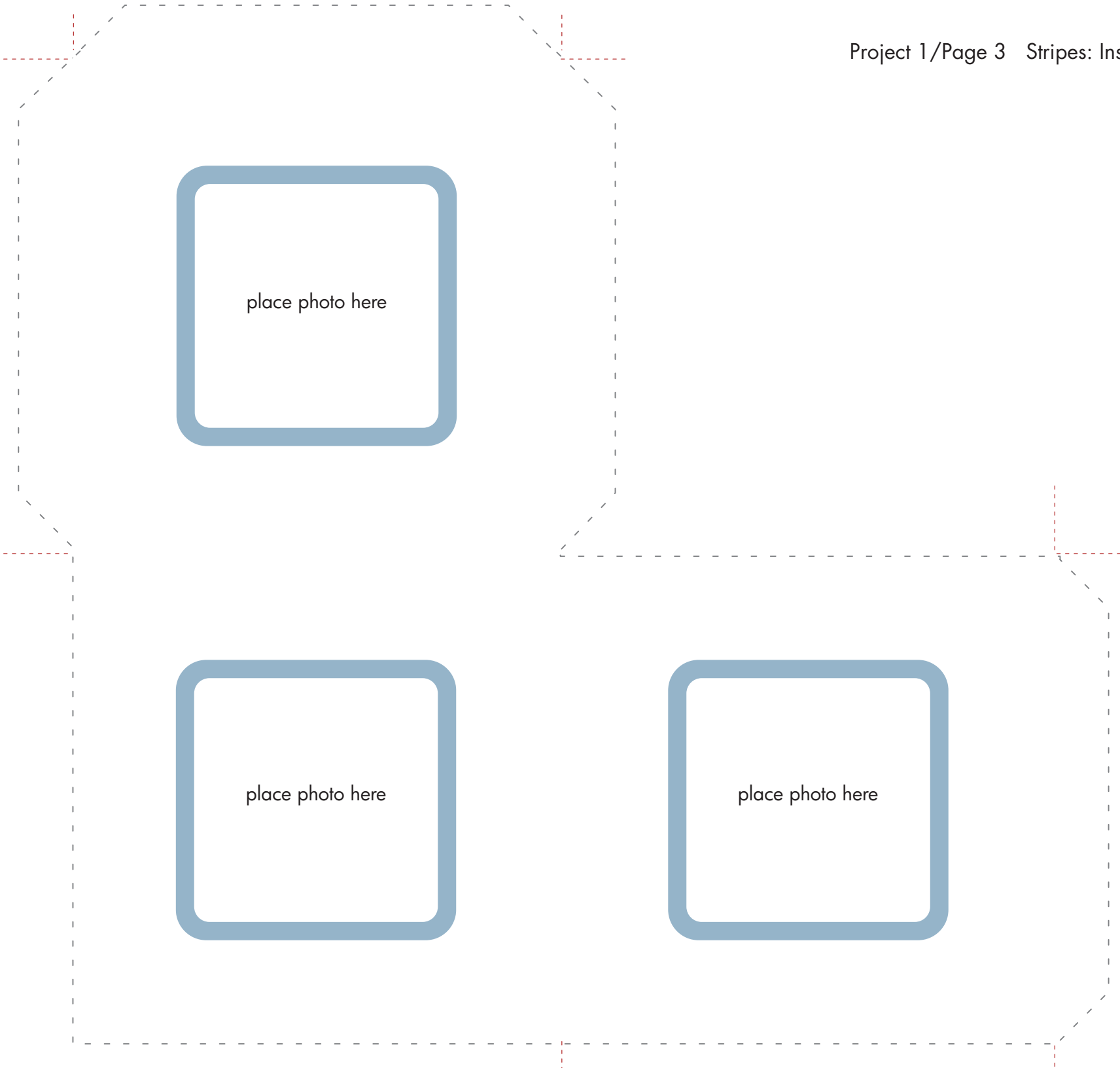
- 4 sheets of card stock
- X-acto knife
- Metal-edged ruler
- Glue stick
- Double-sided tape
- 5 photos trimmed to 2-1/2 inch squares

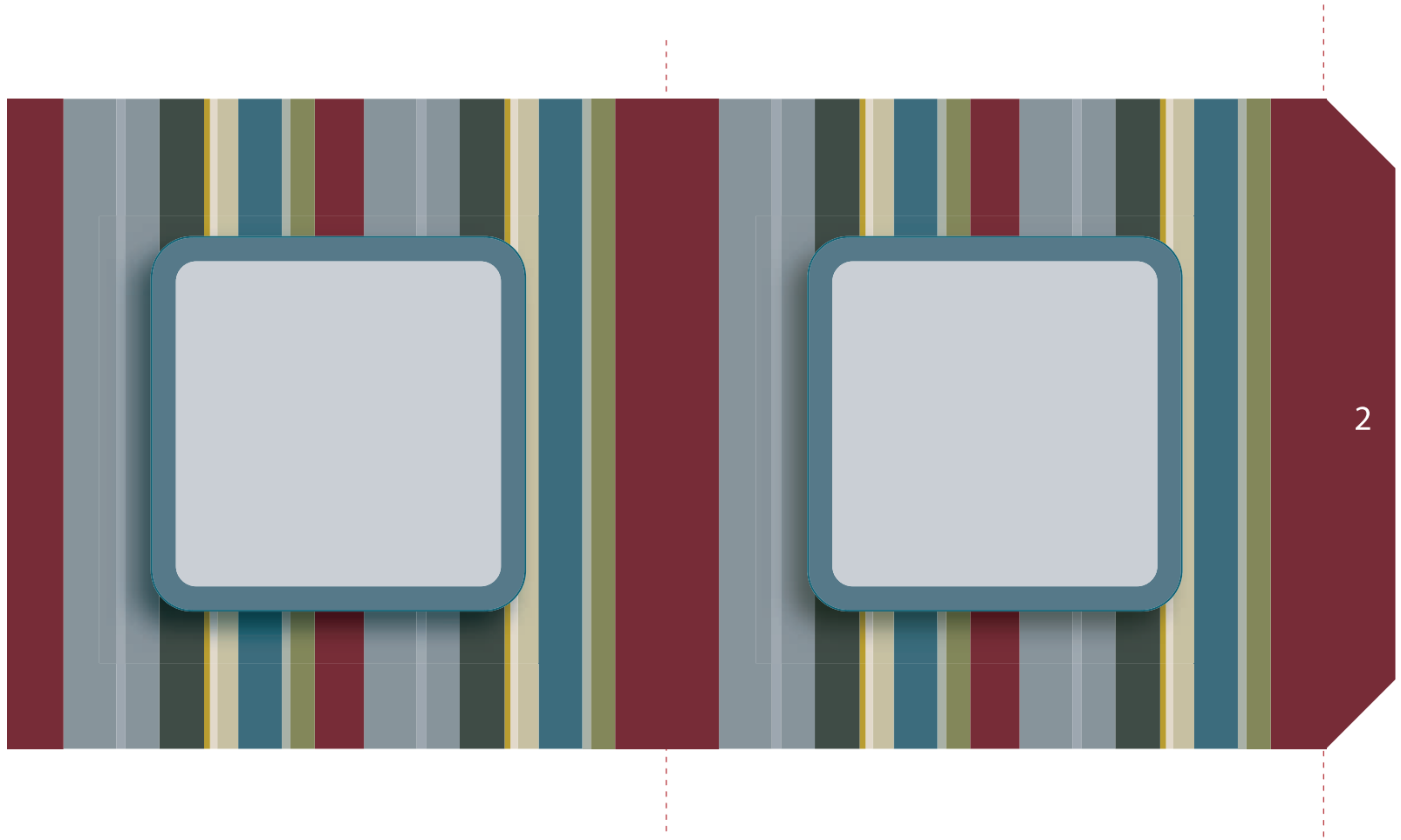
### Instructions

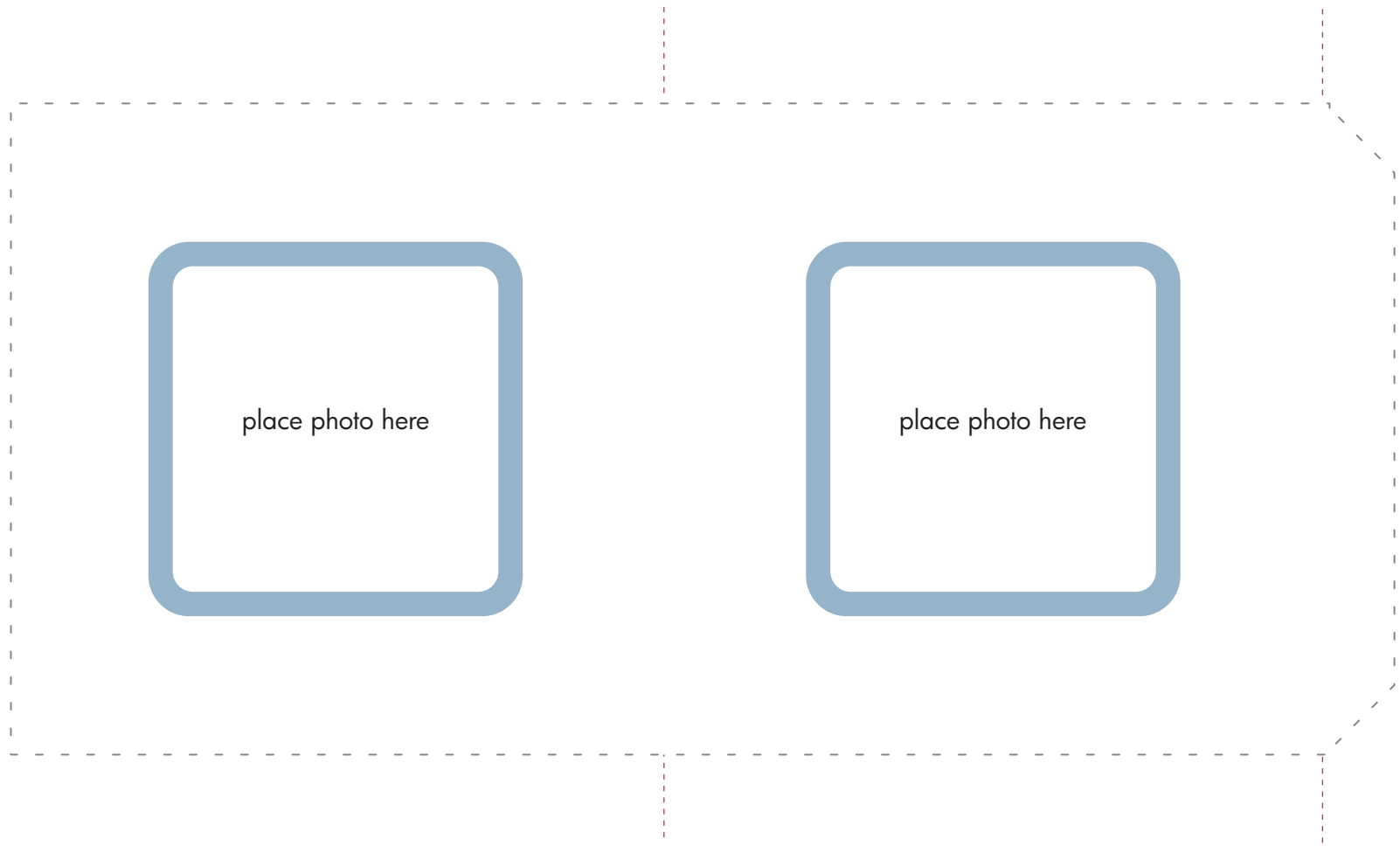
1. Print the art on card stock. Set aside to dry completely.
2. Score the pages to help with folding. To do this, lay a ruler along the red dotted lines, and run a butter knife along the ruler, using medium pressure to create an indentation on the paper. Do this step for each page. (For the sides and top framework page and inside photo page 1, you will need to score a total of six times, and two times on the remaining pages.)
3. Using an X-acto knife and ruler, first cut out the gray squares on both photo cube framework pages to create windows for your photos. Cut out the entire pattern from the pages.
4. Tape your photos on the inside photo pages 1 and 2 as indicated, and then cut out the inside photo pages along the black dotted lines.
5. Apply glue to one of the inside photo pages, photo-side up, and carefully line it up behind the corresponding framework page, pattern facing out. Press firmly in place. Repeat this process with the remaining inside photo page and photo cube framework page. Set aside to dry completely.
6. Carefully fold the glued pieces along the scored lines to begin the cube formation.
7. Apply double-sided tape to the orange tab labeled #1. Place this tab behind the side of the other framework side panel that doesn't have a tab. Repeat this step using the tab marked #2. This should form a cube.
8. Finally, place double-sided tape on the remaining three tabs, and tuck them inside the cube like a box top. To complete the cube, reach ainto the inside of the cube and press all the tabs firmly in place.
