Why is this necessary?

- ◆ By default, the Microsoft Internet Explorer 4.0 for Windows CE only allows for one browser window.
- ◆ Some users want to switch between multiple browser pages
- ◆ The workaround for this is using the `<target="new">` HTML tag.
- ◆ Using this scheme allows users to switch between multiple pages via IE4's **Window** Menu
