

**NAME**

fgname -- find group name

**SYNOPSIS**

```
char *fgname(gid)
int gid;
```

**DESCRIPTION**

fgname accepts gid, an integer group id value, searches /etc/group file for the corresponding group name and returns:

- 1 - if the group id is not found.
- 2 - if fgname had trouble opening /etc/group file.
- <string pointer to group name> - if the group id is found.

`getgrgid(3)` is used which uses `malloc(3)`
